Collaborize has applications in many different markets, and these markets are being approached through a variety of channels. The pricing structure has been designed to encourage broad use by a wide variety of groups, though Burst.com (dba DemocraSoft™) also has the ability to customize the basic product for enterprise applications, for both internal and external use. Collaborize is the first in an anticipated suite of software tools on a common web-based software platform which the company has developed. As part of the reincarnation of Burst.com, we are in the process of changing the name of the company to Democrasoft, Inc. The resolution adopting the new name has been passed by the Board of Directors and approved by the written consent of the holders of a majority of the Company's shares. Regulatory approvals are in process. There will also be a new ticker symbol. Article I of the Company's Amended and Restated Certificate of Incorporation now states: 'The name of the Corporation is DEMOCRASOFT, INC.'
